Hardiness and good aptitude as for grain or forage production.

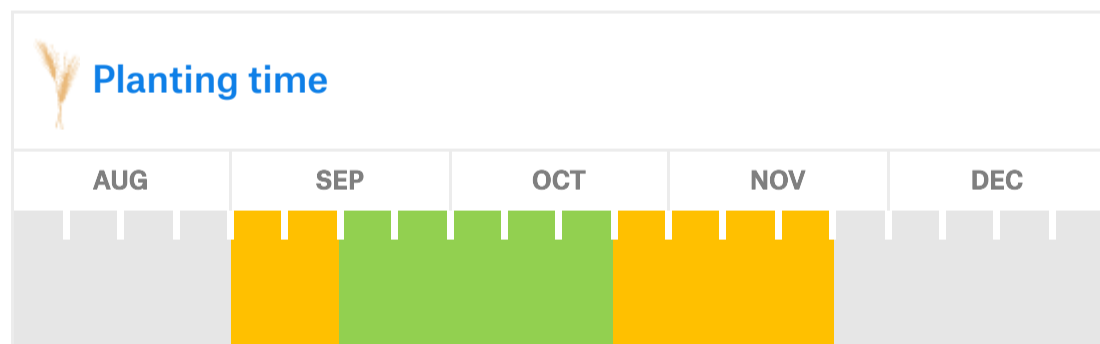

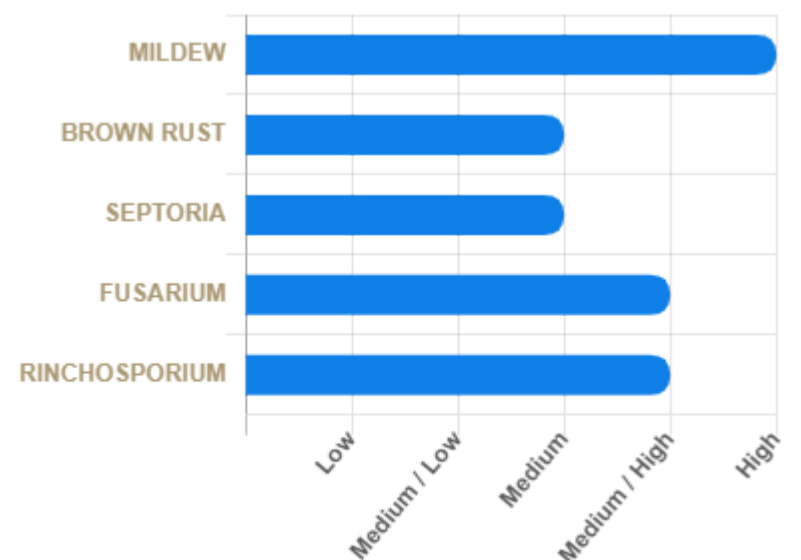
